

Howard Hall Classical Student Dress Code Guidelines

2019-2020 School Year

- A black or brown belt must be worn if there are belt loops in the clothing.
k-2: Optional 3-5 mandatory (for bathroom use purposes)
- (if worn) Undershirts must be solid white.
- Students cannot wear bell-bottom, hip huggers, zip off, sagging pants.
- Winter jackets/coats/hats/gloves may be worn to and from school. They may not be worn inside the building because they are not part of the dress code. They are permitted to be worn inside the classroom. (wear a light sweater/jacket underneath that matches uniform color)
- Attire must be neat, clean, and in good repair. "Sagging" or "bagging" of clothes is not permitted.
- No headgear, visors, sweatbands, doo-rags, bandanas or scarves, etc. A hair band may be worn.
- Blue jeans and pants made of denim fabric may be worn with a Howard Hall spirit or House shirt ONLY ON FRIDAY. Jean or denim overalls (long or short) may not be worn.
- Sunglasses may not be worn inside the building.
- Shorts/skirts/skorts/jumpers must be knee-length (no more than 2 inches above the knee)
- Shirts – Forest green, white, navy, light yellow/ gold (no neon), black polo style, oxford style dress shirt. Shirttails must be tucked in at all times. (Light blue is **not** an approved shirt color this year)
- Slacks/Shorts – Khaki, navy, or black
- Polo dresses same color as uniform shirts.
- Jumpers/Capri Pants – Khaki, navy, or black.
- Shoes – No neon (dress, casual, or tennis with no lights or rollers): toes, heels, and sides must be completely enclosed. Sandals are not permitted. Flat Boots are allowed. Platform shoes are not allowed. No heels, sparks, scales allowed.
- Socks – Must be solid white, navy, brown, or black.
- Shoelaces – Must match the shoe color.
- Sweaters – Same as shirt. Sweatshirts may be worn and must match the uniform colors. NO hooded sweaters are permitted to be worn in the building.
- Fleece Jackets may be worn(match the shirt colors)
- Blazers – Must be black or tan in color.
- Tights – Must be solid (no patterns) white, navy, or black
- Leggings (white, navy or black) must be worn with a skirt, dress or shorts/skorts
- Any questions regarding attire should be discussed with your child's teacher or the principal.
- Administration has the discretion to modify as needed.
